

HOW TO DECONSIGN

1. Collect all of your items. You need to find them on the sales floor. This may take some time, and you should plan several trips.
2. Use a cart to load up your items
3. Take them to the back of the store (same area where you consigned them).
4. Our deconsigning hours are 10am and 2pm, Tuesday through Saturday. (No deconsignment on Sunday; we are closed on Monday.)
5. You will be given a receipt for all items you are taking out of the store. Please sign it and give it to the volunteer who is helping you. She will give you a copy that she will sign.
6. We will not deconsign any item marked at \$5.
7. Please leave the store through the back entrance and show your receipt. If you wish to shop, please come in through the front without your newly deconsigned items.
8. We will help you deconsign through October 30. Any item not retrieved by October 30 will become the property of Les Passees.
