Dear Fellow Members,

I hope all is well with you and your families. As you all know this is the 35th anniversary of the Les Passees Stock Exchange (LPSE) and we are continuing to support the hybrid approach to selling – all items are in-store but select items are on Shopify.

There is not really much to report as all my energy is focused on Stock Exchange. We opened the doors for Preview Party on August 26th and sold about 232 tickets for the event. The number of tickets sold was much lower than normal. I believe this to be the case because of the Shelby County Health Directive had just mandated “masks must be worn at all in door events” due to COVID. With fewer tickets sold, the amount of merchandise sold was also less - about half of 2019.

The Preview Party date was earlier by two or three weeks because the LPSE Committee decided since so many people had been home for the last 18 plus months they probably have been cleaning, reorganizing, and de-cluttering. With this in mind, we assumed that we would be inundated with lots of merchandise and we have been. We are so blessed as it is continuing.

In fact we are now using a system called “setmore” so our consignors can make appointments to consign. It is no longer a “free for all” when consigning as you must have an appointment. However, as always, there are exceptions to the rules.

Concerning our monthly General Membership meetings, we planned on having our September meeting with Fine Arts but due to the spike in COVID the meeting was cancelled. I will have a Zoom meeting this month. However for October there is NOT a meeting but you, as a member, can come in and work a 4 hour shift at the Les Passees Stock Exchange to earn a meeting credit. You choose the time - 10am-2pm or 12pm-4pm any day to include Sunday 1pm-4pm. Please remember we are closed Mondays and open late on

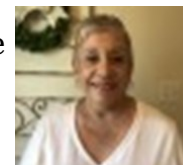


Shirley resides in Germantown, TN with her husband of 24 years, John, and their 16-year-old daughter, Abbey, who attends St. George's Independent High

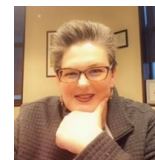

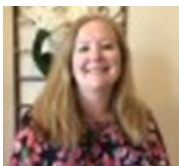

Erin has lived in seven states. She is from North Carolina, but has settled down in Tennessee. Erin is married to Hugh. They have three

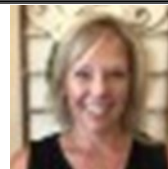
children but are about to be empty nesters. She is a retired marketing professional who is enamored with sports and Les Passes Stock Exchange.
