**Volunteer Hall of Fame:** Les Passees began the Volunteer Hall of Fame in 1993. Each inductee must meet the following criteria.

1. A Les Passees member that stays active while remaining a Senior Plus or Associate member.
2. She volunteers for jobs that others prefer not to do.
3. She rarely misses any Les Passees events.
4. She cannot presently be serving on the Les Passees Executive Board or Board of Managers.
5. No Past Presidents of Les Passees are eligible for this award.

**Frances Etter Volunteer of the Year:** This award was established in 1973 to honor a member for outstanding commitment and service to Les Passees.

1. All membership categories excluding members of the Executive Board and the Junior 1 class are eligible for nomination.
2. The Volunteer of the Year is elected by the Executive Committee, and may or may not be elected annually.
3. The candidate should be an exceptional volunteer who has distinguished herself by her eagerness and willingness to assume responsibilities and duties well beyond her placement.
